Clause 3, page 4, line 26	leave out subsection (2).
Clause 4, page 5, line 40	leave out clause 4
Clause 5, page 6, line 43	<p>add at end “(2) If the Secretary of State is unable to make arrangements for the removal of the person from the United Kingdom within three months from the date of the person’s arrival in the United Kingdom the Secretary of State must:</p> <p>(a) Revoke the declaration of inadmissibility made under section 4(2) in relation to a protection claim, or a human rights claim, and</p> <p>(b) Consider a protection claim or a human rights claim made by the person.”</p>
Clause 6, page 8, line 40	add at end “(2) Regulations under subsection 1 are subject to super affirmative procedure as provided for in the Schedule (Regulations under Section 6: Super Affirmative procedure).”
Clause 8, page 11, line 40	add at end “(8) This section does not apply to a family member who has been living in the United Kingdom prior to the commencement of this Act.”
