What is the Fifth Anti-Money Laundering Directive (5MLD)?

On 10 January 2020, the Fifth Anti-Money Laundering Directive (5MLD) came into force in the UK through the Money Laundering and Terrorist Financing (Amendment) Regulations 2019. It introduced the requirement for <u>obliged entities</u> to report certain information discrepancies to Companies House.

New reporting requirement for obliged entities comes into force.

What is PSC discrepancy reporting?

<u>Obliged entities</u> must let us know if there's a discrepancy between the information on the PSC register and the information they hold about a beneficial owner.

New service will make it easier and faster to report PSC discrepancies.

New online service

Report a discrepancy about a PSC using our new online service. It takes up to 10 minutes. The service will time out after 30 minutes and your answers will not be saved.

Report a discrepancy about a beneficial owner on the PSC register.
