The Scotland Act made provision for a Scottish government of ministers and a Scottish Parliament to which they would be accountable.

The Human Rights Act brought the human rights contained in the European Convention on Human Rights under the jurisdiction of UK courts.

The Public Appointments and Public Bodies etc. (Scotland) Act saw the Law Society of Scotland taking over the Scottish Conveyancing and Executries Board.

The Functions of the Council of the Law Society of Scotland Act meant that the Council could delegate powers to committees.

The Legal Services (Scotland) Act allows for the regulation of alternative

business structures.

**The Legal Profession and Legal** 

Aid (Scotland) Act created the Scottish Legal Complaints Commission, meaning service complaints against solicitors would be removed from the Law Society of Scotland.




The 'Find a Solicitor' website was relaunched, listing every practising Scottish solicitor by location and type of law. It had over 500,000 visits that year.
